Sabeel seeks to deepen the faith of Palestinian Christians, and promote unity among them.
- **BETHLEHEM BIBLE COLLEGE**  
The only Christian training school for Arabic-speaking Christians in Israel and the West Bank.
- **MAR ELIAS SCHOOLS**  
Founded by Archbishop Elias Chacour, this Christian consortium of six schools instructs over 6,000 kindergarten through college age students who come from Jewish, Muslim and Christian backgrounds.

Jerusalem native Nora Kort leads a variety of Christian ministries which bring much needed assistance to those in need.
